Andrew P. Widick of Tullahoma suddenly passed this life on Sunday, May 7, 2023 at 5:22pm at Vanderbilt University Medical Center in Nashville at the age of 60. Memorial Services will be scheduled at a later time.

Mr. Widick, a native of Highland Park, MI, was the son of the late Paul Rupert Widick and Carolyn F. Vance Widick and the stepson of the late Billie Jean Roles of Tullahoma, TN.
