Betty Jane Henninger passed from this life Friday, September 27, 2024, at Vanderbilt Harton Hospital in Tullahoma, Tennessee. She was ninety-nine.

Born on the Fourth of July, 1925 in Cincinnati, Ohio to Winfield and Sylvia Stacey, Betty moved to Tullahoma in support of her husband, Allen D. Henninger, in 1955. She was a loving wife and mother of two sons, Allen Stacey Henninger and David Scott Henninger.

A lifelong member of the First Presbyterian Church in Tullahoma, Betty served as an elder, librarian, Sunday school teacher and women's club member. 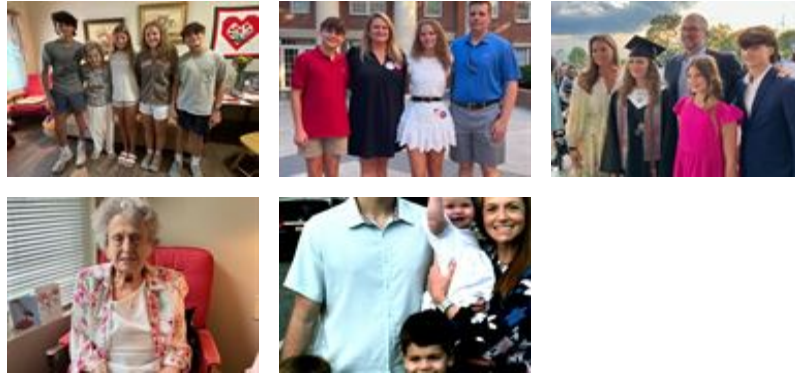
