Florence Wilma Majors Shasteen of Tullahoma, passed this life on Thursday, January 11, 2018 at her daughter's residence in Oakwood, Georgia at the age of 93 years. 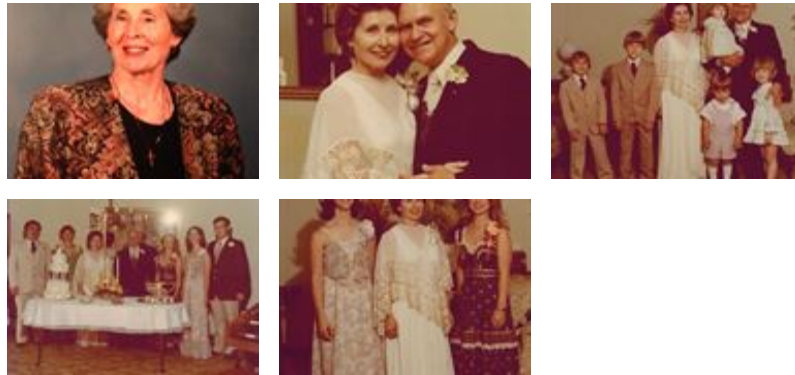
