Mr. Gary Lynn Hall, age 62, passed away Friday, January 4, 2013 at Harton Regional Medical Center in Tullahoma after a short illness. He was born in Monterrey, TN and a lifelong resident of Tullahoma.

He was the son of the late Luther Clarence Hall and Mrs. Ferby Hall of Tullahoma who survives. Mr. Hall was an independent business man who operated many businesses in Tullahoma including the Drewskies Chain of Convenience markets and was currently the owner operator of H and H Health Food Store in the Mall in Tullahoma.

He was a long time and generous member of the Grace Baptist Church.

Mr. Hall is survived by his wife of 32 years, Sharon Cory Hall, a daughter, Ashleigh Lynn Hall and son Drew Preston Hall (Brittany Shelton), all of Tullahoma.
