Janice Anne Plane Petschauer of Manchester, Tennessee passed this earth into the arms of her Heavenly Father on Saturday, April 28, 2018. She was 77. Janice was born on July 27, 1940 in Norwich, England to the late George Plane and Violet Pope Wood. It was while serving as a telephone operator in the Royal Air Force at Brampton Air Force Base near Huntingdon, England, that Janice met Joseph Petschauer, an airman in the U. S.
