Jeanie Ann Ramirez, age 52 of Tullahoma passed away Monday, December 22, 2014 at Vanderbilt University Medical Center in Nashville. Funeral Services will be held Saturday December 27 at 10 AM at St. Paul the Apostle Catholic Church with Father Stephen A. Klasek officiating. Visitation with the family will be Friday, December 26 at Daves-Culbertson Funeral Home from 5 PM – 9 PM with a Rosary Service at 8:30 PM.

A native of Spencer, Iowa, Mrs. Ramirez was the daughter of the late William and Lola Gannon Schomburg. She was a veteran of the U S Marine Corps where she met her husband of 31 years, Rudolph Ramirez. After her husband retired from the U S Marine Corps, the couple moved to Albany, Georgia where they resided for the next 20 years.
