Jerry and his brother Larry were a part of the youth group in my church...1st Church of the Nazarene in Indianapolis. We were an active group, and spent a lot of time at outings together. I was probably considered 'just a kid' to the boys, cause I was only in junior high school, and they were in high school, even though we were all at Tech.*

One memory I have, and have shared with my child and my school kids was a time when (can't remember which boy had the car) a bunch of us piled into their car after a Sunday afternoon gathering of our youth group. We were packed into that car as we drove east towards the new cloverleaf exchange at the then edge of town where the Eastgate Shopping Mall was being built. Each one of us dug deep into pockets and purses to come up with the \$0.29 necessary for one gallon of gasoline! I do believe that we bought a little more, but I have often thought of what fun we had for that little bit of money. Every time the price of gasoline has gone up over the years, I think of this story and wonder whatever happened to Jerry and Larry Osborne.
