Lotus Jean Brown Douglas, aged 80 years, passed away at home on October 11, 2024. She was a private person who enjoyed spending quality time with family and friends, gardening, cooking, and quilting. 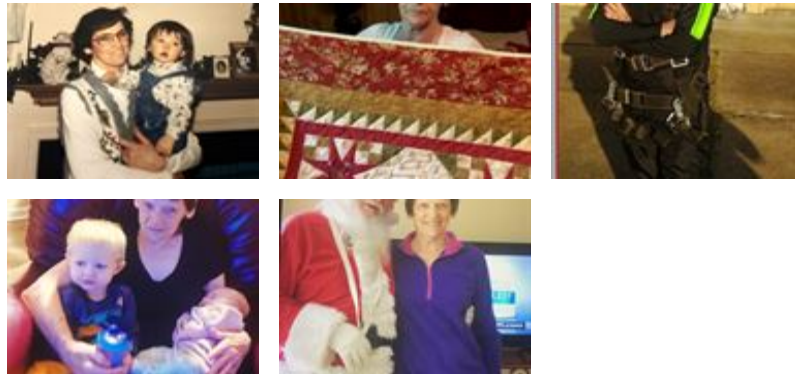
