Marion Montgomery Jr., 78, a resident of Tullahoma, TN passed this life peacefully surrounded by his loving family on Monday, August 29, 2016 at his home. 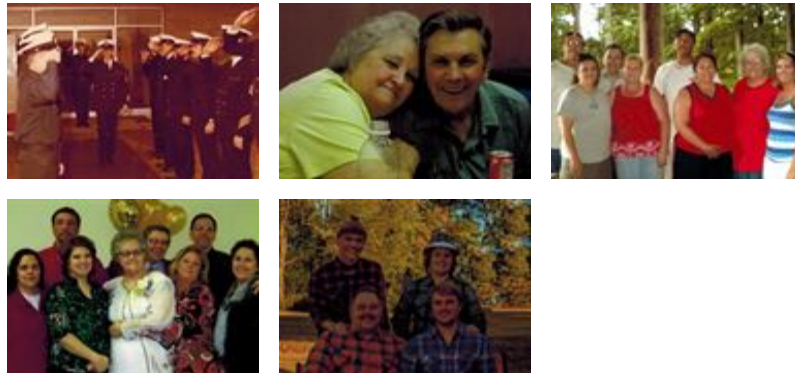
