Michael J Shuran, age 66 of Tullahoma, passed away on Friday, June 10 at Tennova Harton Hospital. 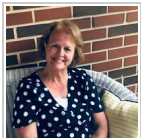

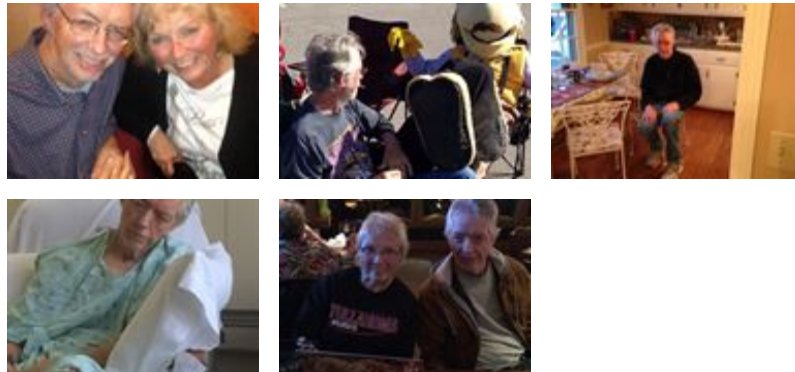
