Mr. Ralph L. Kilts, age 97 of Tullahoma, TN, passed away on July 14, 2016 at his residence.

Mr. Kilt was born on Sept. 19, 1918 to the late William Orval and Emma House Kilts.

Serving his country as a Lt. Col., he was a member of the Army Air Corp during WWII, flying P-38 fighters, and later served in the Air Force Reserves. He also served as a Squadron Commander in the South Pacific along with training other fighter pilots.

A college graduate, he was an Aeronautical Engineer and a manager at Altimill-Microcraft.

A Protestant, he was a Rotarian, a member of the American Legion and enjoyed fishing and gardening.

He is survived by his wife Craigie Powell Kilts along with one daughter Karen Leavesley of Tallahassee, FL and two sons, Ralph "Mike" (Deborah) Kilts of Bradville, TN and Robert Kilts of Cleveland, GA.
