Rebecca (Becky) Stauffer Richcreek of Manchester, TN, passed away on May 2, 2016, at her home, with her family by her side, following a three year battle with breast cancer. Becky was born in Bellefonte, PA on August 4, 1962. 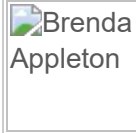
