



## Thomas Eugene Maurer

Thomas Eugene Maurer, age 97, of Tullahoma, Tennessee, passed away peacefully at his home on August 24, 2024. He was born on September 9, 1926, in Dover, Ohio, to Edwin and Edna Maurer.
